Construction site inspections across Great Britain begin

Starting on Monday, 15 May 2023, the inspections, part of a respiratory health intervention initiative, will specifically focus on dust control, checking employers and workers know the risks, plan their work, and are using the right controls.

HSE is carrying out a targeted health inspection initiative focusing on the respiratory risks to construction workers from exposure to silica and wood dust.

The inspection initiative and supporting [Dust Kills campaign](#) aim to support industry by raising awareness of:

- health issues in relation to dust exposure
- the importance of effective control measures in improving construction workers' long-term health
